THE KERALA STATE BIODIVERSITY BOARD REQUIRES DISTRICT COORDINATOR IN KOLLAM AND PATHANAMTHITTA DISTRICTS

Kerala State Biodiversity Board is involved in conservation of biodiversity, its sustainable use and equitable sharing of benefits arising of its commercial use with the help of Biodiversity Management Committees and the public. District Co-ordinator of the KSBB is to liaise with BMCs, general public, other Departments and different agencies in achieving these objectives. The post will be purely temporary and initially only for a period of one year. The period may be extended on the basis of performance.
