- The clearing of NET / SLET / SET will not be required for candidates possessing a PhD Degree as per UGC Regulations / ICAR / AICTE Guidelines.
- 2. A relaxation of 5% shall be allowed at the Bachelor's as well as at the Master's

level for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Classes (OBC)(Non-creamy Layer)/Differently abled ((a) Blindness and low vision; (b) Deaf and Hard of Hearing; (c) Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid-attack victims and muscular dystrophy; (d) Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness; (e) Multiple disabilities from amongst persons under (a) to (d) including deaf-blindness) for the purpose of eligibility and assessing good academic record for direct recruitment. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based only on the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedure.

- A relaxation of 5% shall be provided, (from 55% to 50% of the marks) to the Ph.D. Degree holders who have obtained their Master's Degree prior to19 September, 1991.
- 4. Interested candidates are requested to apply in prescribed format attached below along with the copies of certificates to prove essential educational qualification, age and experience to The Registrar, Kerala University of Fisheries and Ocean Studies, Panangad P.O., Pin 682 506 by post on or before 20 /06 /2023 indicating the post applied for.
- 5. The University reserves the right to restrict the number of candidates to be called for interview on the basis of qualifications/suitability of candidate to the post with experience prescribed in the notification.
